

STATEMENT ON THE PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA PURSUANT TO ART. 13 OF EU REG. 16/679

PARTICIPATION IN THE COMPETITION "ICOONE BEST RESULTS CONTEST"

Who is the controller of my personal data?

I-TECH INDUSTRIES SRL – with registered office at Via Giuseppe Verdi 12, 24121 – Bergamo (BG), operational headquarters at Via I Maggio 4/Q, 40057 - Granarolo Emilia - Loc. Quarto Inferiore – Bologna (BO) which as Data controller of your personal data (hereinafter also "Controller") undertakes to protect your Personal Data.

What data is processed and for what purposes?

Identifying data and contact details, company name, email address, website and personal data of the person that registers. Anonymous data will be requested on customers/patients (age, sex, clinical history, biometric measurements) that underwent the treatment using icoone[®] equipment. The name of the person that used the icoone[®] instrument will also be reported. The data will be processed by the Controller exclusively for the purpose of participating in the prize competition and the organisation of same (including checks that eligibility criteria have been met for participation and the forwarding of communications on the competition), and for the management of any complaints or disputes that may arise from participation in the competition, as well as to fulfil all legal requirements. Personal data will be processed exclusively by the parties expressly appointed for this purpose by the Controller or Data Protection Officer in order to carry out the activities necessary for the correct management of the competition.

An additional purpose is the forwarding of commercial information (newsletters) by the company, for which specific consent must be provided. If you are interested in receiving commercial information on our products you can express your consent in the dedicated area at the bottom of this statement.

What is the legal and optional basis for processing?

Consent pursuant to art. 6 of EU Reg. 16/679. Processing for the above-mentioned purposes is based on the need to respond to requests to participate in the competition and/or prize operation; the submission of data for this purpose is optional though the failure to provide this data will make it impossible to accept the participation request.

How is data processed?

Using manual, electronic and online tools. As regards security, prevention and protection systems are used and constantly updated and monitored in terms of their reliability. Data subjects are requested to omit irrelevant data.

Who are the recipients of the personal data?

Personal data may be shared with the following parties ("Recipients"):

- parties that typically act as Data processors, i.e. i) people, companies or professional practices that provide assistance and consultancy on accounting, administrative, legal, tax and privacy issues relating to our activities and those connected with communications;
- parties with whom it is necessary to interact (e.g. hosting providers or suppliers of platforms for the issuing of emails);
- parties appointed to perform technical maintenance activities (including the maintenance of network equipment and electronic communication networks);
- persons authorised by us to process the personal data required to perform activities strictly connected with our activities, who undertake to guarantee the confidentiality of the data.

Where does the data circulate?

Processing takes place within the EU.

Duration of processing

The duration of processing is connected with the purpose of processing and so personal data will stop being processed at the end of the prize competition/operation, taking account of administrative timeframes. In any case, the winning company will be added to the company's historic archive.

For the processing of commercial information (newsletters) the term is 24 months.

What are my rights?

Data subjects have the right to request the following from I-Tech Industries s.r.l. at any time: confirmation of the existence or otherwise of personal data relating to them, including data that has not yet been registered, and the communication of same in intelligible form. Data subjects have the right to obtain information on: the origin of personal data; the purpose and methods of processing personal data; the method applied in the event of processing using electronic means; the identification details of the Data Controller, the Data Protection Officer and the designated representatives, pursuant to art. 5, para. 2; the parties or categories of parties to whom the personal data may be communicated, or who may become acquainted with same in their capacity as designated representatives in a State's territory, as Data Protection Officers or as Persons in charge of data processing. Data subjects have the right to: ensure their data is updated, amended and, where relevant, completed; ensure that any data processed in violation of the law be cancelled, made anonymous or blocked, including any information that does not need to be stored for the purposes for which it was collected or subsequently processed; receive confirmation that the operations as at letters a) and b) have been made known, also as regards their content, to those parties to whom the data has been communicated or disclosed, except in cases where this is impossible or requires the use of means that are clearly incommensurate with the protected right. Data subjects have the right to oppose, in whole or in part: for legitimate reasons, the processing of personal data relating to them, even though relevant to the purposes for which it was collected; the processing of personal data relating to them for the purposes of forwarding advertising or direct sales materials or for the purposes of market research or commercial communications.

In particular, data subjects may request the following from the Data Controller at any time: access to their data and its rectification or erasure, the restriction of the processing of personal data concerning them, the right to object to such processing, and the right to data portability. Data subjects also have the right to withdraw their consent at any time without affecting the lawfulness of the processing based on the consent given prior to their withdrawal, and the right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority.
